Redwood - Oracle Update

The TCNJ Enterprise Application, Human Resources, and Payroll offices would like to announce that Oracle Cloud is enhancing the user experience and introducing upgrades called "Redwood" for the various modules across the Cloud platform. The start of Redwood rollouts began Monday, March 24th, 2025, with the Time and Labor module for all time-card-eligible employees.

Oracle has shared some of the following benefits of this upgrade:

- Intuitive, eye-catching design.
- A modern, optimized user interface.
- Enhanced workflows.

Time card employees and supervisors who approve time cards will see the updated screens and, in some instances, may need to navigate around a bit differently. While the navigation to these modules will be unchanged, there will be some visual adjustments and enhancements.

This will include display changes to:

- Absence Balance page
- Existing Absences page
- Absence Type dropdown
- Add Absence page

Our offices have been working to prepare job aids for time card employees and time card supervisors that can be found on the payroll web page under the <u>Self-Service tab</u>. The <u>payroll</u> <u>calendar</u> with these due dates can be found on the payroll website.

Did you know you can access your W-2 via ADP iPay? You can find the ADP login by going to the Payroll website or by visiting my.adp.com. Employees who are no longer with TCNJ continue to have ADP iPay access for 3 years to access pay slips and tax documents!
