
Energy Days and the 2025 Thanksgiving Break Schedule

HR's Cozy Recipe Corner

Apple Pie Cookies

These taste like autumn at its best — sweet, spiced, and shareable.

Ingredients:

1 sheet pie dough

½ cup apple pie filling (chopped finely)

1/4 cup brown sugar

1 tsp cinnamon

1 egg (for brushing)



"Gratítude in Every Bite"



Directions:

Cut the dough into small circles, spoon the apple filling into the center, top with another circle, crimp the edges, brush with egg, and bake at 375°F for 18 minutes.

Cool for 5 - 10 minutes and enjoy!
