Changes are Coming Soon to the NJ Paid Family Leave Law

Governor Phil Murphy signed a law that will extend an employee's paid time off from a maximum of 6 weeks, to 12 weeks to care for a sick family member,



or to bond with a newborn, or recently adopted child. These changes also include an increase in the maximum weekly compensation from \$650 to \$860. All changes are scheduled to take effect in July 2020. Click here for additional information.
